PARTICIPATE

If you are in court and want to participate, let the court coordinator or the researchers know. The court coordinator will allow you to complete a survey on an iPad in the courtroom. The survey will take about 30 minutes.

If you are at home, you can access the survey with the URL listed below. You will need to enter the participant ID number provided to you.

After you complete this first survey, you will be sent 3 smaller mini-surveys throughout the year. These mini-surveys will only take 5-10 minutes.

Once a year, you will be asked to complete a 30-minute survey.

We will be randomly selecting some youth to interview. The research coordinator will contact you to schedule an interview if you are selected.
